their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying and being on the northeasterly
side of Gilreath Mill Road, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina,
being known and designated as Tract No. 1, containing 7.32 acres, on plat entitled,
"Division of the R. T. Stone Estate", dated May 5, 1966, prepared by H. C. Clarkson,
Jr., recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book 000 ,
page 6 , and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the middle of Gilreath Mill Road, said pin being the
joint front corner of Tracts 1 and 2 and running thence with the middle of said
Road N 62-19 W 370 feet to an iron pin in the middle of the intersection of Gilreath
Mill Road and Plantation Road; thence with the middle of Plantation Road N 22-30
E 892.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S 59-15 E 192 feet to an iron pin; thence S 58-
