to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Deles Woodrow Boren and Benjamin G. Boren, their heirs and assigns forever

All my right, title and interest in and to, All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the westerly side of Welcome Street at the southwesterly corner of the intersection of Welcome Street and Welcome Road near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, S. C., and being known and designated as Lot No. 9 on plat of the property of Talmer Cordell made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, on March, 1950, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book X, at page 179 and, according to said plat, described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the southwesterly corner of the intersection of Welcome Street and Welcome Road, and running thence along the southern side of said Welcome Road, S. 59-30 W. 166.7 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9; thence along the joint rear line of said lots, S. 14-0 E. 32.8 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence along the line of Lots Nos. 9 and 10, N. 72-27 E. 160.5 feet to an iron pin on the westerly side of Welcome Street; thence along the westerly side of Welcome Street, N. 14-0 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner, being the same property conveyed to Deles Boren by deed of Benjamin G. Boren dated July 6, 1964, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 753, page 316.

Provided, however, that the said Martha E. Boren shall have the right to occupy said premises rent free during her widowhood so long as she maintains the premises and pays all taxes assessed against it and maintains fire and extended coverage insurance in the amount of \$4,000.00, this right of occupancy to be personal to the said Martha E. Boren and, upon her remarriage or moving from the premises, it shall be terminated.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
