 heirs of James Rosemond, deceased, that is, Hattie Miller Rosemond,
 George Edward Rosemond, Kathleen Rosemond Powell, McKinley Fields, Doris
 F. Turner, Johnny Rosemond Fields, Charles Fields, Vivian Fields, Samuel
 Fields, James Fields, McArthur Fields, Willie Mae Fields, Constance Fields
 Jackson, Deborah Fields, Patricia Fields (the last twelve being the heirs
 of Willie Mae Fields, deceased) in and to:

All that certain tract of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South
