8. The general nature of the business for which the corporation is organized is (it is not necessary to set forth in the purposes powers enumerated in Section 2.2) (12—12.2 Supplemental Code 1962)

The corporate purpose and business of the corporation, in addition to all of the rights and authority prescribed by the statutory laws of South Carolina, shall be to own, ω nduct and operate a general mortuary business, and to do any and all acts necessary and conducive to that end.
