

TRUST AGREEMENT.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into at Augusta, Georgia, this July 5<sup>th</sup>, 1946, by and between Harryette Palmer Jones, of the City of Augusta, Richmond County, Georgia, hereinafter for convenience sometimes called the Trustor, as party of the first part, and The National Exchange Bank of Augusta, a banking corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States, with its principal office and place of business in the City of Augusta, Richmond County, Georgia, hereinafter sometimes called the Trustee, as party of the second part:

W I T N E S S E T H:

That, WHEREAS, the Trustor is at the present time vested with a remainder interest in all the property belonging to the estate of her father, Harry H. Jones, who died a resident of Richmond County, Georgia, on May 1, 1937, leaving a last Will and Testament which was dated October 11, 1930, and which is now duly probated in the office of the Court of Ordinary of Richmond County, Georgia, in which Will it was provided that after the payment of certain debts and the satisfaction of a specific legacy contained therein, all the property of the testator should pass to his wife, Stella Benton Jones, who is the mother of the Trustor, so long as she shall live and remain the widow of said testator, with remainders over at her death or remarriage to such of the children of the testator, including the Trustor herein, who might be in life at said time, with the children of deceased
