to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said GLORIA B. HART, her heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the South side of Hartsville Street, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 229 on plat of Section 3 of Orchard Acres, made by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, May 1960, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book QQ, page 143, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Hartsville Street, at joint front corner of Lots 228 and 229, and runs thence along the line of Lot 228, S. 3-21 E. 223.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 62-05 E. 110.1 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lots 230, 231 and 232 N. 3-08 W. 281 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Hartsville Street; thence along Hartsville Street, S. 86-39 W. 95 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed of W. B. Ducker dated September 15, 1961, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 682 at page 151.
