unto JIM HUFF, his heirs and assigns, forever, all my right, title and interest as the sole surviving heir of Lucinda Turner Massey to:

ALL that certain lot or parcel of land in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as Lot No. 1, on a plat of a subdivision of William Booker as noted in Plat Book G, page 98, Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, less a triangular strip conveyed from said lot No. 1 as noted in Deed volume 274, page 375, the said lot No. 1, being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at the corner of a street and Bethel Street, and running thence along the line of said Bethel Street, N. 15-50.
