8. The general nature of the business for which the corporation is organized is (it is not necessary to set forth in the purposes powers enumerated in Section 2.2) (12—12.2 Supplemental Code 1962)

To develop, own, maintain, operate, lease or in anyway deal in and with race tracks and facilities and to do any and all things necessary or conducive to said purpose. To buy, acquire, sell, mortgage and lease real and personal properties of every nature and kind, and to do any and all things and acts by law now authorized for corporate entities.
