

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in the State and County aforesaid and more particularly described as Lot 59 of Section 1 of Caroline Court, as shown by plat recorded in the RMC Office of Greenville County in Plat Book EE at page 44, and having, according to said plat, the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southwestern intersection of Manhattan Boulevard and Maubrey Street and running thence with the Western side of Maubrey Street S. 25-15 W. 240 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot 47; thence along the joint oine of Lots 59,47 and 48 N. 64-45 W. 90 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lot Nos. 58 and 59; thence along the joint line of said lots N.25-15 240 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Manhattan Boulevard; thence with Mathattan Boulevard S. 64-45 E.90feet to the beginning corner.
