ALL that lot of land lying in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Fairview Township, located on the western side of the Simpsonville-Fairview Road adjoining lands of Furman Brashier, Sr. (now L. J. Vaughn) and lands now or formerly of R. M. Coley and being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the western edge of the Simpsonville-Fairview Road on the line of R. M. J.
