All that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the east side of Poplar Drive (formerly New Pelham Road) and the west side of Line Street Extension in the City of Greer, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, bounded by lands now or formerly of Donald F. Jackson, W. E. Sloan, Myrl Green, William E. Sanders, Pearl Cantrell and Mildred K. Berry, and being identified and described on the County Block Book Map as Lot No. 16 in Block 1 of Sheet G-2, District 285.

The above described lot is all the remainder of the property conveyed to J. R. Greene by deed of Cleo Holtzclaw, et al., recorded in Deed Book 206, page 230, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
