C. Petton and Melvin K. Younts running a six inch cast iron water line 1,017 feet in an easterly direction down Belmont Drive so as to serve Lots 5 through 13 and property on the opposite side of said street as shown on said plat, and

WHEREAS, the total cost of such line, including 1,017 feet of six inch cast iron pipe and one six inch cap and blow off, will be Two Thousand Five Hundred Porty Three and 65/100 Dollars (\$2,543.65).
