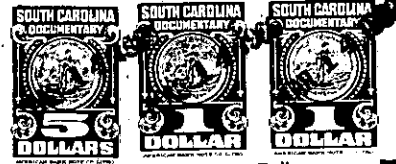

unto K & D Enterprises, Inc., its successors and assigns:

ALL those pieces, parcels or lots of land, situate, lying and being on the southern side of Long Hill Street, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 79 and adjoining one-half of Lot 80 of a subdivision known as Augusta Road Hills, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at Page 33, and Plat Book L, Pages 56 and 57, and having according to a plat prepared by R. B.
