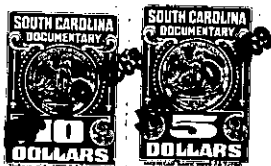

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southwestern side of Hathaway Circle, in Paris Mountain Township, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 104 of a subdivision known as Stratford Forest, and having according to a plat of said subdivision prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated February 25, 1957, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book KK at page 89, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Hathaway Circle at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 103 and 104, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 103 S. 71-00 W. 327.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 9-55 E. 141 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 104 and 110; thence with the line of Lot No. 110 S. 76-12 E. 350.8 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 104, 105, 109 and 110; thence with the line of Lot No. 105 N. 4-07 E. 244.4 feet to an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Hathaway Circle; thence with the Southwestern side of Hathaway Circle N. 51-03 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the Southwestern side of Hathaway Circle N. 30-28 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to "Protective Covenants Applicable to Stratford Forest" recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 578 at page 1 and to drainage and utility easements, if any, affecting said lot.

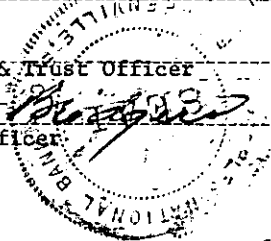
