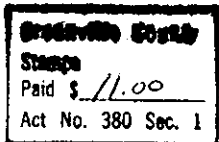

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s)

DAISY W. McCORKLE, HER HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, FOREVER:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the western side of Balfer Drive, being shown as Lot No. 31, on plat of Wade Hampton Gardens, Section III, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "YY", at Page 179, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Balfer Drive at corner of Lot No. 32, and running thence with the western side of said Drive, S. 0-39 W. 120 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 30; thence with line of said lot, S. 76-35 W. 262.8 feet to a point in a creek; thence with said creek as the line, the traverse of which is N. 65-20 W. 164.4 feet to a point at corner of Lot No. 35; being also the center of the right-of-way of Duke Power Company; thence with line of Lots Nos. 35, 34, 33, and 32, N. 74-33 E. 421.6 feet to the point of BEGINNING.

The within conveyance is subject to restrictions of record, and is also subject to utility easements and rights-of-way of record or on the ground.

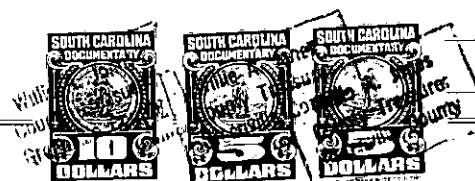
