

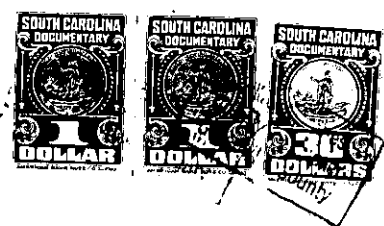

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release  
unto Greenville Asphalt Co., Inc.

All that lot of land in the county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, on the west side of White Horse Road, containing .34 acres more or less, designated as tract "B" on plat thereof made by J. R. McClure, R.L.S., July 26, 1969 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of White Horse Road, corner of property this day sold to D. B. Cox & Fitzhugh Lee Saunders; thence with the line of said property S. 76-59 W. 155.44 feet to an iron pin; thence turning N. 12-10 E. 136.4 feet to an iron pin corner of property of the grantor; thence with the line of said property N. 74-11 E. 88.52 feet to an iron pin on the west side of White Horse Road; thence with the west side of said Road S. 14.36 E. 128.14 feet to the beginning corner.  
This is a portion of the same tract of land conveyed to the grantor by Louise Earl and India E. Pepper by deed recorded August 12, 1957 in deed vol. 582 page 150 of the RMC Office for Greenville County. This conveyance is made subject to any recorded restrictive covenants, easements or rights of way.
