8. The general nature of the business for which the corporation is organized is (it is not necessary to set forth in the purposes powers enumerated in Section 2.2) (12-12.2 Supplemental Code 1962)

A. To buy, sell, own, lease, improve, develop, subdivide and deal in real estate; to construct and erect homes, dwellings and industrial and business buildings; to make loans in connection with the purchase or improvement of real estate and to furnish advisory and consulting services in matters pertaining to real estate development and financing.

B. To purchase, acquire and conduct the business of any other person, firm or corporation which is, or has been engaged in the activities herein authorized.

C. To purchase, hold, manufacture, lease, sell and otherwise deal in all kinds of goods, wares, merchandise and personal property of every description.

D. To engage in, conduct and operate any other business which may be deemed by the Board of Directors to be adapted directly or indirectly to add to the profits of its principal business or to increase the value of its property.

9. Provisions which the incorporators elect to include in the articles of incorporation are as follows:

Either officer of the corporation is authorized to sign legal documents, including notes, mortgages or deeds, for and in behalf of the corporation.
