OLLIE FARNSWORTH
REAL PROPERTY AGREEMENT

South Carolina National Bank
Greenville, S. C.

In consideration of such loans and indebtedness as shall be made by or become due to THE SOUTH CAROLINA NATIONAL BANK OF CHARLESTON (hereinafter referred to as "Bank") to or from the undersigned, jointly or severally, and until all of such loans and indebtedness have been paid in full, or until twenty-one years following the death of the last survivor of the undersigned, whichever first occurs, the undersigned, jointly and severally, promise and agree

1. To pay, prior to becoming delinquent, all taxes, assessments, dues and charges of every kind imposed or levied upon the real property described below; and

2. Without the prior written consent of Bank, to refrain from creating or permitting any lien or other encumbrance (other than those presently existing) to exist on, and from transferring, selling, assigning or in any manner disposing of, the real property described below, or any interest therein; or any leases, rents or funds held under escrow agreement relating to said premises; and

3. The property referred to by this agreement is described as follows:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Brushy Creek Township, Anderson County, State of South Carolina, containing 2.48 acres, more or less as shown on that certain plat prepared by John C. Smith, Surveyor, dated April 20, 1957, and which is of record in the office of the Clerk of Court for Anderson County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 44, at page 130. Such property being more fully described as follows: Being bounded on the North by South Carolina Highway No. 81, fronting thereon a distance of 66.4 feet; on the Northeast of East by lands now or formerly owned by S. L. Harrison for a distance of 506 feet; on the Southeast and south by lands now or formerly owned by H. P. Harrison for a distance of 270.3 feet; on the west and southwest by lands now or formerly owned by H. P. Harrison for a distance of 522.6 feet.

That if default be made in the performance of any of the terms hereof, or if default be made in any payment of principal or interest, on any notes hereof or hereafter signed by the undersigned, the undersigned agrees and does hereby assign the rents and profits arising or to arise from said premises to the Bank and agrees that any judge of jurisdiction may, at chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver of the described premises, with full authority to take possession thereof and collect the rents and profits and hold the same subject to the further order of said court.

4. That if default be made in the performance of any of the terms hereof, or if any of said rental or other sums be not paid to Bank when due, Bank, at its election, may declare the entire remaining unpaid principal and interest of any obligation or indebtedness then remaining unpaid to Bank to be due and payable forthwith.

5. That Bank may and is hereby authorized and permitted to cause this instrument to be recorded at such time and in such places as Bank, in its discretion, may elect.

6. Upon payment of all indebtedness of the undersigned to Bank this agreement shall be and become void and of no effect, and until then it shall apply to and bind the undersigned, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, and inure to the benefit of Bank and its successors and assigns. The affidavit of any officer or department manager of Bank showing any part of said indebtedness to remain unpaid shall be and constitute conclusive evidence of the validity, effectiveness and continuing force of this agreement and any person may and is hereby authorized to rely thereon.
