All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Mauldin, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot 80 on a plat of "Addition to Knollwood Heights," prepared by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 4-F at Page 18, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
