in consideration of Two Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100 (\$2,500.00) Dollars,

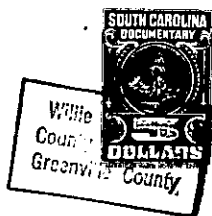

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Located within the Town of Simpsonville at the Southeastern Corner of the intersection of South Street and Cox Street and being known and designated as Lot No. 11 and the northwestern portion of Lot No. 12 of a subdivision known as Hill Crest, as shown by plat thereof by W.D.
