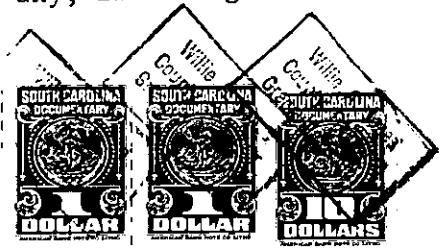

SCOTT AND TRULA P. SCOTT, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Northern side of Dundee Lane, in Paris Mountain Township, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 29 as shown on a plat entitled "Stratford Forest", prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated February 25, 1957; recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book KK at page 89, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Dundee Lane at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 29 and 30 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 30 N. 13-30 W. 221.8 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 28, 29, 30 and 31; thence with the line of Lot No. 28 S. 78-18 W. 263.0 feet to an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Dundee Lane; thence with the curve of the Northeastern side of Dundee Lane, the following courses and distances: S. 35-06 E. 130.0 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 64-23 E. 150.0 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 84-53 E. 100.0 feet to the point of beginning.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Furman University, dated November 13, 1956, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 567 at page 397.

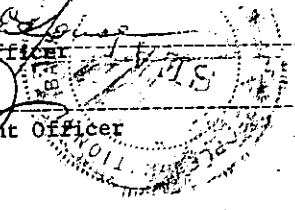
