the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

GEORGE M. DUMIT, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 12 of a subdivision known as "Buxton" according to a plat entitled "Buxton" by Piedmont Engineers and Architects which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book 4N, at Pages 2, 3 and 4, and according to a plat entitled "Revision of Lots 12 and 13, Buxton", by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, dated March 28, 1972, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book 4M, at Page 203, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Winsford Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 12 and 31, and running thence along Winsford Drive, N. 36-30 W. 95.0 feet to an iron pin; thence with the intersection of Winsford Drive and Norwich Drive, N. 8-50 E. 35.2 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of Norwich Drive; thence with Norwich Drive, N. 44-56 E. 132.0 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 12 and 13; thence with the joint line of Lots 12 and 13, S. 43-10 E. 120.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46-38 W. 171.3 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

This conveyance is subject to all easements and rights of way shown on the recorded plat of Buxton and to protective covenants recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 910, at Page 491, et seq.
