the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Earline C. Bowers, her heirs and assigns forever my one-half interest to:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the building and improvements thereof, situate, lying and being on the northeast side of Edgewood Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C. being shown as Lot No. 1 on plat of property of B.R. O'Neill, prepared by C. C. Jones & Associates, Engineers, dated March, 1955, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book JJ, at Page 166, and being more particularly shown on plat of Rvey E. Bowers, dated October 6, 1956, prepared by C. C. Jones & Associates, Engineers, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Edgewood Drive, at the joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2, which iron pin is 631 feet from the intersection of Edgewood Drive and Mills Avenue, and running thence along the joint line of Lots 1 and 2, N. 47-23 E. 167.4 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of said lots; thence turning and running N. 34-34 W. 8.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 50-29 W. 61.1 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of said unnamed 20 foot street; thence along the southeast side of said unnamed 20 foot street, S. 45-14 W. 176.2 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Edgewood Drive; thence along the northeast side of Edgewood Drive, S. 56-49 E. 65 feet to the point of beginning.

This being the identical parcel conveyed, subject to existing restrictions and easements from B. R. O'Neill to Rvey E. and Earline C. Bowers, by deed dated October 10, 1956, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 563, at Page 148.
