KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that THE TOWN OF FOUNTAIN INN, A BODY POLITIC, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY SIX THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED SEVEN and No/100

(\$776,507.00) DOLLARS, including principal and interest, payable under the terms of an agreement existing between the Grantor and Grantee and pursuant to the terms of Section 8 of Act No. 745 of 1967, as amended by the Act of July 14, 1969, South Carolina General Statutes, and pursuant to Act No. 688 of the 1969 Acts and Joint Resolutions and Paragraph 8B thereof, have granted, bargained, sold and released unto the said GREENVILLE COUNTY SEWER AUTHORITY, A BODY POLITIC, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS FOREVER:

All of the trunk lines within Sewer Collection system and facilities owned by the Grantor, including, but not limited to, any and all pumps, pipes, valves and all appurtenances belonging or in any way related to the said Collection system and including all easements and rights of way and land used in connection with said system and owned by, in possession of, or claimed by the said Grantor, except and less, however, Lateral Collection lines which are not conveyed. The words "trunk line" shall be defined and described in accordance with Public Law 660.

The system conveyed herein is more particularly described and shown by a Plat entitled "Additions and Improvements to the sanitary sewer system to the Town of Fountain Inn, South Carolina project No. WPC-SC-131" prepared by Davis & Floyd Engineers, Inc., Greenwood, S.C. dated March 23, 1971 and being the lines as marked on sheet 2 designated by green dotted lines on the original and signed by Carl C. Lanford, Engineer and the remainder of lines shown on various pages throughout the drawings that are designated by heavy line marked eligibility PL 660 and being recorded in RMC office for Greenville County in Plat Book Page in Clerk of Court's Office in Laurens County, in Plat Book Page

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the Grantor covenants and agrees to receive and use the funds payable under the aforementioned agreement for the sole purpose of retiring outstanding Sewer Bonds issued for construction of these facilities.
