Vehicle shall not peas a fuseral procession, nor shall the funeral be closely followed or joined by persons who are strangers. It is not an occasion for idle curiosity. Entrance to and exit from the cemetery by vehicle or other-wise shall be by way of the regular established entrance place.

Vehicles are not to turn around upon any of the roads, but should follow one of the circular driveways to their objective. They shall keep on the right and when they stop shall be at least six inches from the lawn.

This trust fund will be used by the Corporation to provide annual care hareafter of lawns, flowers, shrubs, trees and to keep straight and plumb all headstones, ourbing and other stone work. The Corporation is not responsible for the west or damage to monuments, headstones, curbings, or other stone work by the elements, and will not repair or replace same. The attent of the obligation of the Corporation for such annual care is limited to the funds available from such trust fund.
