(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Edward N. Bishop and Blanch
Bishop, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land near Marietta in Greenville County, South
Carolina situate on the east side of a proposed road being shown
as Lots 18 and 19 on plat of Linda Acres made by J. C. Hill, May
2, 1957, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville, S. C. in Plat
Book EE, Page 84 and having, according to said plat, the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of a proposed road at the
joint front corner of Lots 17 and 18 and runs thence along the line
of Lot 17 N. 71-10 E. 136.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 23-00 E.
202.1 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lots 10 and 11
S. 47-05 W. 243 feet to an iron pin on the east side of a proposed
road; thence along said proposed road N. 10-15 E. 133 feet to an
iron pin; thence still along said proposed road N. 9 W. 171.5 feet
to the beginning corner.
