KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, JAMES T. LYNN, Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, of Washington, D. C., acting by and through the Federal Housing Commissioner, (hereinafter referred to as "Grantor"), for and in consideration of the sum of ---Five Thousand Five Hundred and no/100----- DOLLARS (\$ 5,500.00), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto T. R. HALL

(hereinafter referred to as ("Grantee(s)"), and to the heirs and assigns of said Grantee(s), the following described real estate situate in the County of GREENVILLE, State of South Carolina, to wit:

ALL that lot of land with improvements, situate, lying and being on the Northern side of Seventh Street in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 42, Section 4, on a plat of Judson Mills Village, dated January, 1941, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book K at Pages 75 and 76, reference to which is hereby craved for the metes and bounds thereof.

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Being the same property conveyed to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development by deed of Frank P. McGowan, Jr., Master dated Dec. 8, 1970, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County on Dec. 8, 1970 in Book 904, Page 281.

BEING the same property acquired by the Grantor pursuant to the provisions of the National Housing Act, as amended (12 USC 1701 et seq.) and the Department of Housing and Urban Development Act (79 Stat. 667).

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise appertaining or incident.
