Helmas of Spartanbutg, South Carolina, my attorney for me and in my name as surviving Executrix and Trustee under the last Will and Testament of Isaac Andrews, deceased, to receive and collect all rents, interest and other income, to pay all bills and other commitments, to disburse all net income due beneficiaries, and to release all mortgages and notes upon payment in full, and to execute my name as such sole surviving Executrix and Trustee. This appointment as attorney includes the entire estate of Isaac Andrews, deceased, comprising the Andrews Building, and all other property and investments contained in the General Rent Account of the Estate of Issac Andrews. As my attorney, he will also invest any surplus funds in securities, notes, mortgages, property, etc.
