to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Dan River Inc., its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, South Carolina, near Woodside Cotton Mills, being known and designated as Lot "B" according to a plat of Woodside Mills, Greenville, South Carolina, prepared by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, March 7, 1950, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northern side of East South Sixth Street at the joint corner of Lots Nos. "A" and "B", which point is 75 feet West of the Northwestern intersection of Vance Street and East South Sixth Street, and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 15-49 E. 100 feet to a point; thence N. 74-11 W. 75 feet to a point, joint rear corner of Lots "B" and "C"; thence with the joint line of said lots S. 15-49 W. 100 feet to a point in the Northern side of East South Sixth Street; thence with the Northern side of said street 75 feet to the beginning corner.
