DOWN For a such loans and indebtedness as shall be made by or become due to THE SOUTH CAROLINA NATIONAL BANK OF CHARLESTON (hersinafter referred to as "Bank") to or from the undersigned, jointly or severally, and until all of such loans and indebtedness have been baid in full, or until twenty-one years following the death of the last survivor of the undersigned, whichever first occurs, the undersigned, jointly and severally, promise and agree

- To pay, prior to becoming delinquent, all taxes, assessments, dues and charges of every kind imposed or levied upon the real property described below; and
- 2. Without the prior written consent of Bank, to refrain from creating or permitting any lien or other encumbrance (other than those presently existing) to exist on, and from transferring, selling, assigning or in any manner disposing of, the real property described below, or any interest therein; or any leases, rents or funds held under escrow agreement relating to said premises; and
- 3. The property referred to by this agreement is described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Pineknoll Drive at joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2, and running thence with the line of Lot 1, S. 48-30 W., 180 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 41-30 W., 80 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 3, N. 48-30 E., 180 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of Pineknoll Drive; N. 43-30 E., 180 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of Pineknoll Drive thence with Pineknoll Drive, S. 41-30 E., 80 feet to the point of beginning.

The affidavit of any officer or department manager of Bank showing any part of said indebtedness to remain unpaid shall be and constitute conclusive evidence of the validity, effectiveness and continuing force of this agreement and any person may and is hereby authorized to rely thereon.
