BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Finley Street and running thence N. 4-30 E. 160 feet, more or less, along Finley Street to a point; thence S. 87-29 E. 170 feet, more or less to a point; thence S. 28-2 E. 190 feet, more or less, to a point; thence N. 87-1 W. 285 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to Leonard O. King by deed of Robert A. Davis et al, dated July 13, 1971 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville, S. C. in Deed Book 920, Page 276.

Conditioned upon the said Purchasers paying to the Seller the full and just sum of \$25,500.00, of which amount the sum of \$1,000.00 has this date been paid (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) and the balance of \$24,500.00, with interest thereon from date hereof at the rate of eight (8%) per cent, to be paid as follows:
