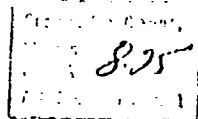
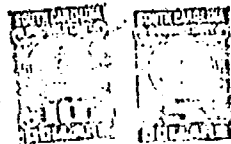
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by  
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Charles H. Moore, his  
heirs and assigns forever: All of our, right, title and interest in  
the following described real estate:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on the northern corner of  
the intersection of Deatur Street and Bleokley Avenue, and being  
known and designated as Lot No. 14, of Block D, Fair Heights, as  
shown on a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in plat Book F at page 257, and being more particularly  
described according to a plat by Pickell and Pickell, Engineers,  
dated December 12, 1949, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern corner of the intersection  
of Deatur Street and Bleokley Avenue, and running thence along  
Deatur Street, N. 58-40 W. 150 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner  
of Lots Nos. 13 and 14; thence along the line of Lot No. 13, N. 31-20  
E. 50 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 12, 13, 14  
and 15; thence S. 58-40 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Western  
side of Bleokley Avenue, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 14 and 15;  
thence along the Western side of Bleokley Avenue, S. 31-20 W. 50 feet to  
the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to Archie Frank Mathis by deed of  
Edgar A. Carter recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County  
in Deed Book 555 at page 127. The grantors herein and Marjorie M.  
Leonard are the sole heirs at law of the late Archie Frank Mathis
