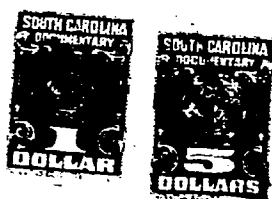

All that piece parcel or lot of land, purchased by me from Mrs. Mattie S. Campbell and Corrie Lee Campbell, sole heirs at law of John R. Campbell, deceased, on February 11, 1946, and recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County in Deed Book 286 at book 438, and having the following metes and bounds to wit (such description copied from the above mentioned deed:

"..In Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on the Public road leading by J. L. Campbell's on a branch of Horse Creek, waters of Reedy River. Bounded by lands of Clarentine Austin, land deeded to William D. Snipes, and James L. Campbell. Said property containing Nineteen and one fifth (19 1/5) acres more or less and having the following lines to wit:

BEGINNING at stone xlll N.M. at the northeast corner and running thence ^{851.40} S 4-7/8 W 12.90 to a stone, xlll O.M. (On old plat, P. O. gone); thence ^{1024.32} N. 85 W 15.52 to stone Xlll O. M.; thence N 7 3/4 E 12.40 to stone ^{316.40} x lll N. M.; thence S 87 E 14.90 to the beginning corner. ^{983.40}

This being a part of the tract of land conveyed to James L. Campbell by Anna Miller by deed bearing date of January 21, 1891, and recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County in Book XX, page 650, and is known as part of the Donaldson land, and being the same property conveyed to John R. Campbell
