POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Sidnie Brockman, a resident of Greenville, South Carolina and temporarily residing in Wake County, North Carolina, have made, constituted and appointed and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint my brother, Ernest Decatur Brockman of Camden, South Carolina my true and lawful attorney-in-fact, pursuant to the provisions of North Carolina General Statute 47-115.1 and pursuant to the laws of the State of South Carolina for me and in my name and stead to do and perform the following matters and things:

- 1. To make deposits in my name in the South Carolina National Bank, Greenville, South Carolina, or any of its branches or in any other bank in which I have accounts or establish bank accounts before this power of attorney is revoked; to endorse any checks payable to me for deposit in any account I might have; to sign and issue checks on any account I have in the South Carolina National Bank, or any of its branches, or in any other banks in which I establish accounts before this power of attorney is revoked; to deposit and withdraw monies from any accounts I might have, whether checking or savings accounts, or any account I open in the future.
- 2. To collect all monies due me by any individual, firm, corporation or governmental agency whatsoever, on account of any matter or thing, and including, but not limited to, annuity checks, Social Security checks, pension checks, interest checks and others, and to give in my name valid and binding receipts for all monies so collected.
- 3. To demand from any individual, firm, corporation or governmental agency, the possession of any and all articles of personal property belonging to me and to take the same into his possession and, in my name to execute receipts for all such articles so received by him.
- 4. To use any and all of my said funds, from any source, in any bank, or elsewhere, for my support, maintenance, medical and hospital expenses and well being, keeping in mind the standard of living to which I am accustomed. If other funds are not available for the purposes set forth in paragraphs above, then my attorney-in-fact is authorized to sell any property I may own, real or personal, without order of the Court or any other authority to accomplish said purpose.

I direct that my attorney-in-fact shall keep records of all properties coming into his hands for any reason whatsoever and expenditures for the purposes hereinabove set out, but it shall not be necessary to file any accounts with the Clerk of Superior Court of Wake County, North Carolina or the equivalent Clerk of Court of any county in South Carolina or any other governmental agency pertaining to the powers, duties and acts herein set forth.
