

6. The grantors herein expressly reserve unto themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns forever the right and power to relocate the said right of way and/or any sewer line that may be installed at their own expense, for whatever reason they may deem necessary. In such event, grantors shall pay all necessary expenses incidental to said relocation of said sewer line and right of way and shall convey a new right of way to the grantee herein, or its successors or assigns.

7. The grantors have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the grantee, their successors and assigns forever the property described herein and the grantors further do hereby bind their heirs, successors, executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular said premises to the grantee, the grantee's successors or assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
