County, State of South Carolina on North side of West Washington Street, being,
 known and designated as Lot No. 1, and having the following metes and
 bounds, according to a plat made by C. M. Furman, Jr., dated April 15,
 1920 and recorded in Plat Book "E" at page 240, R.M.C. Office for
 Greenville County:

Beginning on West Washington Street at joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and
 2, and running thence N. 41-40 E. 75 feet to an iron pin on 10 foot
 alley; thence with said alley, S. 48-50 E. 17.1 feet to an iron pin on
 10 feet alley leading from West Washington Street; thence with said
 alley to an iron pin on West Washington Street; thence with said Street
 N. 48-50 W. 18 feet to the beginning corner.

The alley shown on the above mentioned plat, situate between Lot No. 9
 and the other lots on said plat, is not a public alley, but is laid off
 for the mutual benefit and convenience of the owners of said lots.

Also, all that certain lot of land situate, lying and being in the
 County of Greenville and State of South Carolina on the North side of
