all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township,

County, State of South Carolina containing 58 acres, more or less, situate on
the northwestern side of Talley Bridge Road.

This is the remainder of 83 acres conveyed to J. Charlie Johnson by
B.F. Johnson on October 22, 1940 in deed book 226, page 288. J. Char-
lie Johnson died intestate in 1961, leaving his widow, Minnie Jane
Johnson, and five children, Willie H. Johnson, Louise J. Hughes, John
W. Johnson, Annie Marie Parnell and George Marshall Johnson. The in-
terest of the widow was conveyed to the grantees in deed book 1038,
page 198 on June 18, 1976 and the interest of George Marshall Johnson,
deceased was conveyed to Jesse H. and Louise J. Hughes and Willie H.
and Lillie B. Johnson by Jesse H. Hughes, etal. on October 7, 1976
in deed book 1044 page 211 .

The purpose of this deed is to place the ownership of the tract in the
four remaining children of J. Charlie Johnson, in equal shares.
