THIS AGREEMENT made this 6th day of 1977, by and between Murray Real Estate, Inc., hereinafter called "MURRAY", and the City of Greenville, South Carolina, acting by and through its Commissioners of Public Works, hereinafter called "THE CITY":

WHEREAS, on or about March 5, 1902, Fanny G. Gwinn gave a certain right-of-way to Paris Mountain Water Company, its successors and assigns, over and through land in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, as shown recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, at Deed Book HHH, Page 393; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Public Works for the City of Greenville, South Carolina, as assignee and successor to the Paris Mountain Water Company, and Murray Real Estate, Inc., as assignee and successor in title to Fanny G. Gwinn, desire to amend the foregoing right-of-way agreement so as to permit the relocation of said Commission's water line or lines as it passes through a certain parcel of land located on the southeastern side of Rutherford Road and being more fully described by a deed from J. L. Murray to Murray Real Estate, Inc., dated December 31, 1954, and recorded on January 14, 1955, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 516, Page 193.

WHEREAS, it is the intention of said parties that the City, acting by and through its aforesaid Commissioners, is to have, hold and enjoy along the relocation of said water line any and all of the rights, title, interests, and privileges heretofore acquired under the right-of-way agreement of Fanny G. Gwinn afore-
