

Tract Sixteen

An undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to that piece, parcel or tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina located on the South side of the road leading from Highway No. 29 to the Air Base containing one (1) acre and being the same property conveyed to Charles J. Spillane and J. R. Cleveland by deed of Mae B. Solesbee, as Administratrix, c.t.a. of the Estate of Paul Bradley, deceased, dated March 31, 1967 and recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office in Deed Book 816 at Page 571, recorded March 31, 1967.

Tract Seventeen

An undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina described as Lot No. 73, Section One, as shown on plat of subdivision of Abney Hills, Brandon Plant, recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office in Plat Book QQ at Page 56-59, and being the same property conveyed to J. R. Cleveland and Charles J. Spillane by deed of Calvin H. An undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina located on the South side of Fourth Street (formerly Jackson Street) in Brutontown being the same property conveyed to J. R. Cleveland and Charles J. Spillane by deed of E. Tract Nineteen

An undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina described as Lot No. 72 of plat entitled Subdivision for Abney Mills, Poinsett Plant, recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office in Plat Book QQ at Page 51. This property is known as No. 52 Cain Street and being the same property conveyed to Charles J. Spillane and J. R. Cleveland by deed of Leon D. Smith dated August 23, 1968 and recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office in Deed Book 851 at Page 183, recorded August 28, 1968.

Tract Twenty

An undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lots 8, 9, 10 and 11, Block B of subdivision known as Norwood Heights, according to plat of said subdivision recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E at Page 217, except, however, a triangular strip across the rear of Lots 8 and 9, which triangular strip has heretofore been conveyed. This is the same property conveyed to Charles J. Spillane and J. R. Cleveland by deed of Brenda Jane B.
