All our right, title, interest and estate in and to all that piece,
parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South
Carolina, containing 1.05 acres and according to plat made by Carolina
Surveying Company, June 6, 1979, recorded in Plat Book 7-A, at Page 37,
having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on line of property of B. W. Masters 239.9
feet, more or less, in a southerly direction from the intersection of Robinson
Road and Carpin Drive and running thence S. 82 E., 326.8 feet to an old iron
pin; thence S. 6-30 W., 200.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 82 W., 131.3 feet
to an old iron pin; thence N. 8 E., 100 feet to old iron pin; thence N. 82 W.,
200 feet to an iron pin on Robinson Road; thence with Robinson Road N. 8 E.,
100 feet to the point of beginning.

This is part of the property conveyed to E. D. Robinson by the

conveyed her interest to said Albert Haywood (as Charles A. Haywood) by deed
recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 340 at Page 502.
