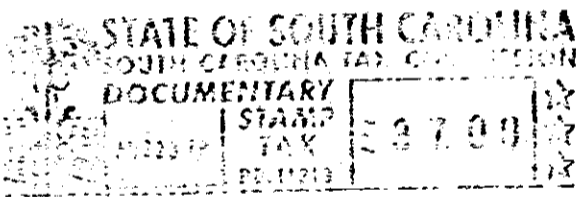
ALL that certain piece, parcel or unit, situate, lying and being in the State
