Beginning at a pin on the west side of Rowley Street, one hundred fifty (150) feet from Park Avenue and running thence N. 20-19 E., 50 feet with Rowley Street to an iron pin; thence N. 77 W. 100 feet, more or less to pin in line of lot of E. N. Mittle; thence S. 20-19 W., 50 feet to an iron pin on driveway between lots of India P. Asbury (now deceased) and W. W. 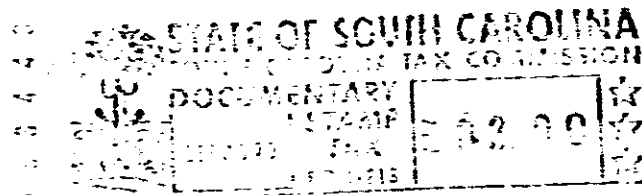

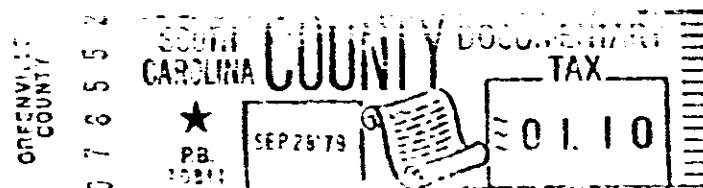
