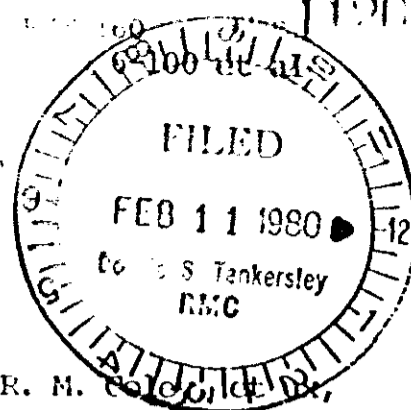


AMENDMENT TO RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

COUNTY OF GREENVILLE



WHEREAS, by Right of Way Agreement executed by R. M. Caldwell, Jr., dated July 21, 1949 and recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. in and for said County in Book 387 Page 283, (hereinafter referred to as Original Agreement), TRANSCONTINENTAL GAS PIPE LINE CORPORATION (hereinafter called Transcontinental) is the owner of a right of way and easement for pipe line purposes across the lands described therein situated in Greenville County, South Carolina, reference being here made to said Original Agreement and its records for a complete description of the lands involved and all other purposes; and

WHEREAS, Cad Jones Pride, III, (hereinafter called Grantor), is the present owner of a portion of the lands covered by the said Original Agreement, and

WHEREAS, Transcontinental has heretofore constructed four pipe lines across Grantor's said lands in accordance with said Original Agreement and may in the future from time to time desire to construct additional pipe lines thereto, and Grantor has requested Transcontinental to enter into this agreement for the purposes of limiting and defining Transcontinental's right of way.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between Transcontinental and Grantor that, insofar as that portion of the lands described in the Original Agreement and presently owned by Grantor are concerned, said Original Agreement shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

1. Transcontinental's permanent right of way shall be 152 feet in width, the side lines of same being located 40 feet northwesterly of and 112 feet southeasterly of and parallel to the centerline of Transcontinental's most northwesterly presently existing pipe line, being the 30 inch pipe line constructed in the year 1950. During the periods of original construction of additional pipe lines and maintenance or replacement of existing pipe lines, Transcontinental shall have the right to clear and use, as temporary work space only, reasonable areas adjoining each side of said permanent right of way.
2. Grantor shall make no use of said 152 foot right of way which would affect or endanger Transcontinental's pipe lines or interfere with the construction of additional pipe lines.
