Ballenger and Maree L. Ballenger; thence with the common line of this tract and other property belonging to Charles D. Ballenger and Maree L. Ballenger, S. 23-18 W. (passing an iron pin at 35.4 feet) 279.5 feet to an iron pin on the line of property now or formerly identified as property of the Geanie L. Ballenger died testate on October 14, 1933, as evidenced by his estate file recorded in the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 307, File 18. Under his Last Will and Testament, the said C. W. Ballenger devised said property to his wife, Martha E. Ballenger, and to his children, Everett Guy Ballenger and Maree Lucretia Ballenger. The said Martha E. Ballenger died intestate December 9, 1941 as evidenced by her estate file recorded in the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 446, File 15, leaving as her sole heirs at law her children, Everett Guy Ballenger and Maree Lucretia Ballenger. The said Everett Guy Ballenger died testate on July 20, 1969 as evidenced by his estate file recorded in the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 1093, File 9. Under his Last Will and Testament, Everett Guy Ballenger devised his interest in the subject property to his wife, Una J. Ballenger, and to his children, Charles D. Ballenger, Thetis B. Rush and Martha B. Lesley. The said Una J. Ballenger died testate on August 11, 1978 as evidenced by her estate file recorded in the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 1528, File 11. Under her Last Will and Testament,
