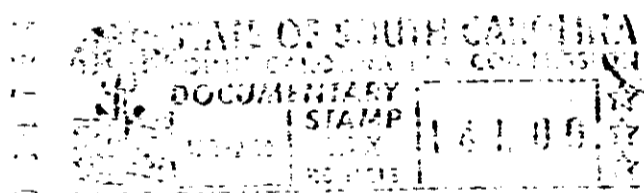
JOHN S. MARTIN AND SUSAN J. MARTIN, their heirs and assigns, forever:
