ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate at the Northwest corner of 1st Street and 1st Avenue (also known as New Fincastle Road), near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots 1 and 3 of Block "F" on plat of subdivision known as Park Place, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "A", page 119, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
