in consideration of FORTY TWO THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$42,000.00) DOLLARS, which is the consideration for the interest of all the heirs of Frank Yeargin, deceased, which will be conveyed by this and other deeds from the heirs of Frank Yeargin, deceased, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto:

All my right, title and interest in and to:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Highland Township, on branch waters of Mush Creek, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 17½ acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:
