All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and the County of Greenville, Highland Township, and being shown on plat of property prepared for John W. Barbare, Jr. by James H. Gregory, R.L.S. on February 26, 1982, to be recorded herewith, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a spike in the center of Pink Dill Mill Road, and running thence along the center of Pink Dill Mill Road N. 66-33 E. 130 feet thence along the boundary of Joan B.
