All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 38, of a subdivision known as Elizabeth Heights, as shown by a plat thereof, dated May 1, 1956 by Madison H. Woodward, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book KK, at page 11, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

No residence to cost less than seven thousand five hundred (7,500.00) dollars shall be erected on said lots; no residence shall be erected on any lot unless said lot has fifty feet or more frontage; no residence shall be built on any lot nearer than thirty feet to the front line; no outside toilets permitted and sewage to be disposed of by approved septic tanks; no business buildings shall be erected on any lot except lots fronting on Staunton Bridge Rd.

This is the identical property conveyed to Rex and Mae B. Wigington on 1/31/59 and recorded 2/3/59 in the Office of the RMC for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 616, page 170. Rex Wigington died intestate on 2/20/64, leaving as his heirs his wife, Mae B. Wigington, and only child, Ray Wigington. His estate was dismissed satisfactorily in the Probate Court's records for Oconee County.
