

13. This Agreement shall remain executory and shall survive the closing of the sale of Parcel No. 3 from the Church to Glenn.

14. The Church's access rights to its property and the access rights of John Wesley United Methodist Church to its property shall not be impaired or changed by any development of Glenn or its assigns without first obtaining the written consent and approval of Church.

15. This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties hereto and no representations, inducements, promises or agreements, oral or otherwise between the parties not embodied herein shall be of any force or effect.

16. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns. Wherever used in this Agreement, the singular shall include the plural, the plural singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders as the context may require.
